Highlights of MBF Partner Situations in Haiti

Hopital Sainte Croix in Leogane

- More patients arriving at HSC as other hospitals and clinics close their doors.
- More patients who cannot pay as businesses close, people lose jobs and banks reserve cash and only distribute small amounts per day.
- · Daily shortages of medicines, supplies and oxygen.



Women and Child's Primary Care Center at Darbonne

- Like HSC, more patients are coming, many from the mountains are arriving on foot without shoes having traveled quite far.
- More patients are unable to pay for care.
- Availability of supplies and medicines are a constant challenge.



FSIL Nursing School

- More students are in financial need as businesses close and fewer people can find jobs.
- Concern for staff and student safety while commuting (mostly by foot since there is so little fuel.)
- Students are supplied food at the school, but sometimes they don't want to eat but rather share it with their family because the families have so little.
